### Disclaimer Text

I have read and acknowledged the Parent/Guardian Transportation/Pick Up Approval Form included in Australian Cricket's Policy for Safeguarding Children & Young People. I understand that I need to complete this form if anyone other than the Parent/Guardian is transporting or picking up my Child/Young Person. I will also detail any custody arrangements, restraining orders or other details that the Club/Association should be aware of. In the event that there are custody arrangements or restraining orders, the Club/Association should sight any court documentation or confirm arrangements with both parents/guardians.
